in wilsonianism american foreign relations specialist lloyd e ambrosius has compiled

his published and unpublished essays on woodrow wilson s liberal ideology and statecraft during and after world war i although the president failed in his pursuit of a new world order his legacy of wilsonianism the principles of national self determination economic globalization collective security and progressive historicism continued to shape u s foreign relations throughout the american century ambrosius examines the american roots of wilson s liberal internationalism the dilemmas and contradictions in his principles and the problematic consequences of u s efforts to implement wilsonian ideals without fully appreciating the world s cultural pluralism as well as its economic and political interdependence offering a pluralist variant of the realist tradition in international relations ambrosius stresses the centrality of power but maintains that culture and political economy as well as military strength determine the balance of power within and among nations or empires consequently he concludes making the world safe for democracy has been more problematic in practice both at home and abroad than proclaiming wilsonian principles in the abstract

from one of our most acclaimed historians a wise and provocative call to re examine the way we look at the past not merely as the story of incessant conflict between groups but also of human solidarity throughout the ages investigating the six most salient categories of human identity difference and confrontation religion nation class gender race and civilization david cannadine questions just how determinative each of them has really been for while each has motivated people dramatically at particular moments they have rarely been as pervasive as divisive or as important as is suggested by such simplified polarities as us versus them black versus white or the clash of civilizations for most of recorded time these identities have been more fluid and these differences less unbridgeable than political leaders media commentators and some historians would have us believe throughout history in fact fruitful conversations have continually taken place across these allegedly impermeable boundaries of identity the world as cannadine shows has never been simply and starkly divided between any two adversarial solidarities but always an interplay of overlapping constituencies yet our public discourse is polarized more than ever around the same simplistic divisions and manichean narrative has become the default mode to explain everything that is happening in the world today with wide ranging erudition david cannadine compellingly argues against the pervasive and pernicious idea that conflict is the inevitable state of human affairs the undivided past is an urgently needed work of history one that is also about the present and the future

on april 28 1946 a small group of american wives and children arrived at the port of bremerhaven west germany the first of thousands of military family members to make the trans atlantic journey they were the basis of a network of military communities little americas that would spread across the postwar german landscape during a 45 year period which included some of the cold war s tensest moments their presence confirmed america s resolve to maintain western democracy in the face of the soviet threat drawing on archival sources and personal narratives this book explores these enclaves of americanism from the u s government s perspective to the grassroots view of those who made their homes in cold war europe these families faced many challenges in balancing their military missions with their daily lives during a period of dynamic global change the author describes interaction in american communities that were sometimes separated sometimes connected with their german neighbors

in international relations since the end of the cold war many of the world's leading scholars examine the cold war legacy the authors examine several key issues including the relationship between democracy and peace the cold war and the third world superpowers the role of post cold war nuclear weapons

geopolitics and globalization collided in the 1970s and their collision produced difficult challenges for the makers of american foreign policy a superpower transformed explains how policymakers across three administrations worked to manage complex international changes in a tumultuous era and it explores the legacies of their efforts to accommodate american power to new forces stirring in world affairs

the historical dictionary of international relations is a general guide to the theory and practice of the relations between states and between states and other actors on the world stage it introduces readers to the real world operations of international relations and is thus concerned with the actual relations between states organizations groups and people it also offers introductory information about the various theories old and new that help explain these relations why they happen and the possible alternatives that might be available now or in the future moreover some of the key thinkers of these theories are discussed the historical dictionary of international relations contains a chronology an introduction and an extensive bibliography the dictionary section has over 200 cross referenced entries on real world operations of international relations the actual relations between states organizations groups and people this book is an excellent resource for students researchers and anyone wanting to know more about international relations

after the heads of state and government of almost all european countries the usa and canada signed the final act of the conference on security and cooperation in europe in helsinki on august 1st 1975 little was heard about the csce process however far away from the headline grabbing meetings between the leading politicians of the usa and the ussr as well as the geneva negotiations on disarmament the helsinki process proved to be an efficient framework for the east west negotiations the inconclusive belgrade csce meeting of 1977 1978 after six months the delegations were only able to agree on a brief final document was nevertheless a significant milestone for the csce process itself negotiation rules were drawn up interpreted negotiated and re negotiated the contributions to this volume offer solid insights

in the war after the war johannes kadura offers a fresh interpretation of american strategy in the wake of the cease fire that began in vietnam on january 28 1973 the u s exit from vietnam continues to be important in discussions of present day u s foreign policy so it is crucial that it be interpreted correctly in challenging the prevailing version of the history of the events kadura provides interesting correctives to the different accounts including the ones of the key actors themselves president richard nixon and secretary of state henry kissinger foremost among them in so doing kadura aims to forge a synthesis between orthodox and revisionist interpretations of this important period kadura finds that the strategy employed by nixon and kissinger centered on the concepts of equilibrium strategy and insurance policy that approach allowed them to follow a twofold strategy of making a major effort to uphold south vietnam while at the same time maintaining a fallback strategy of downplaying the overall significance of vietnam whether they won or lost on their primary bet to secure south vietnam nixon and kissinger expected to come through the crisis in a viable strategic position

john keane a leading scholar of political theory tracks the recent development of a big idea with fresh potency global civil society in this timely book keane explores the contradictory forces currently nurturing or threatening its growth and he shows how

talk of global civil society implies a political vision of a less violent world founded on legally sanctioned power sharing arrangements among different and intermingling forms of socio economic life keane s reflections are pitted against the widespread feeling that the world is both too complex and too violent to deserve serious reflection his account borrows from various scholarly disciplines including political science and international relations to challenge the silence and confusion within much of contemporary literature on globalisation and global governance against fears of terrorism rising tides of xenophobia and loose talk of anti globalisation the defence of global civil society mounted here implies the need for new democratic ways of living
